The Order of St John, as a chivalric order with Her Majesty
The Queen as our Sovereign Head, admits its members and conducts
its promotions based upon these values. And if you are a member of

ensuring that your behaviour and your actions are modelled on these
values. But unlike other orders of chivalry, selection and promotions
